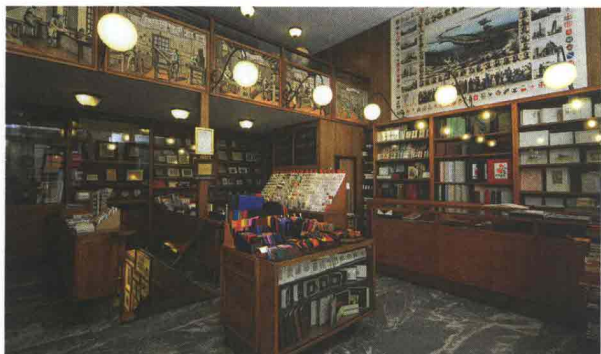

LIBRERIA BOCCA

Founded in Turin in 1775, this iconic bookstore gradually expanded its business with the opening of other branches in Paris, Florence, Rome and Milan. Still operative today, the bookstore in the Galleria - accredited with 'Bottega Storica' (Historic Workshop) certification - is the oldest in Milan. For lovers and collectors of art books but not only, it specializes in the sale of Italian and international books and the production of books and newspapers. It also offers a number of exclusive services including the evaluation or search for out-of-print publications, editorial consultation and the promotion of cultural events and debates. ORNELLA BIJOUX

Since 1944, this artisanal workshop has been creating exquisite handmade costume jewelry. Drawing inspiration from an archive of approximately 40,000 styles, each unique piece attests to the designer's remarkable creative flair and passion for experimenting with new solutions. Exquisite mini-sculptures and unique pieces created by the so-called 'Queen of Bijoux', Maria Vittoria Albani Scala, who has received multiple awards including the latest one dedicated to the 'Masters of Italian Arts and Crafts'. In addition to designing collections for Biki, Céline, Swarovski, Dolce & Gabbana and Borbonese, in 2000, Ornella Bijoux was accredited with 'Bottega Storica di Milano' status.

LORENZI BY LARUSMIANI

Located in the heart of the Quadrilatero, since its inception, G. Lorenzi has always been a point of reference for aficionados of shaving kits and related articles. Following its closure in 2014, its sought-after collection boasting unique pieces including rare knives, desk items, smoking articles, toiletries and shaving kits is now featured at the Larusmiani flagship store, renowned for its high-quality men and women's apparel. The vast collection was put together in the 1930s by the founder of the eponymous Giovanni Lorenzi cutler's shop and currently includes roughly 4,200 items originating from all over the world.
